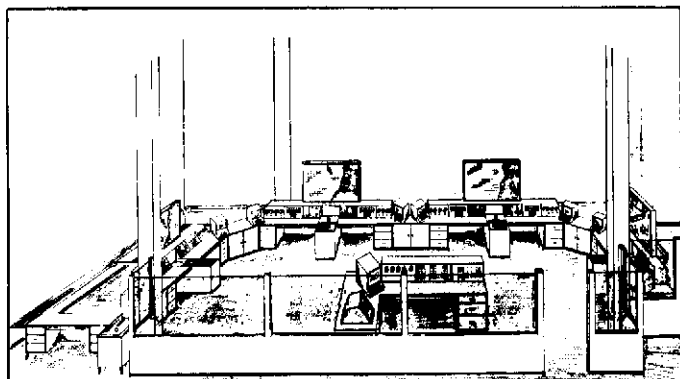
APCO Evaluation Committee
