


The critical communication and collaboration platform would also include:

 A **polling module** that would allow stakeholders to gather responses and real-time location from individuals through voice calls, text and email.



Targeted messaging, allowing emergency managers to send alerts based on a resident's location. Specific neighborhoods will only be notified about an emergency.



A **one-click conference bridge** that would bring all the key stakeholders on the line to discuss an incident and execute actions.



Free **personal safety profiles** that provide crowd-sourced information, such as names of family members, medical conditions and other critical information, from residents to agencies.



Text-from-911, which would enable 9-1-1 telecommunicators to initiate a two-way conversation if a resident initiates a call and can't speak. Quickly resolve abandoned 9-1-1 calls by confirming if they were accidental dials or an actual emergency.



Live video streaming, providing first responders with better situational awareness of what's happening on scene.

Protecting an entire community is a complex and challenging priority for emergency managers, 9-1-1 teams and first responders.

Having accurate information, reliable tools and an effective communication strategy will help them have a clear understanding of all the updates and changes around an emergency or critical event, enabling them to do all they can today and every day.
