It is now time for President William (Bill) Miller to appoint the committees of APCO for his 1974-75 year as President.


It is impossible for a President-Elect to know which members contribute to APCO and which do not. The ONLY person that knows if the committee member is active and productive is the Committee Chairman.


I feel the least I can do for those APCO members who have worked hard to complete the objectives of their committees is to issue a National APCO Certificate of Appreciation.
