SUBJECT: Proposal to Register APCO Logos


It has been brought to the attention of the Board of Officers that there is nothing on record to indicate that the APCO LOGOS (shield) has ever been registered or copyrighted.

It is the opinion of the Board of Officers that the Association should in some manner protect its identifying insignia from the possibility of its being duplicated or otherwise unofficially used by others.

Toward this end, the Board proposes to have the APCO shield insignia (logos) registered, copyrighted or otherwise in the best manner protected from fraudulent use.

If this office does not hear from you to the contrary within fifteen (15) days of the postmark on the envelope of this letter, we will proceed to take this precautionary step as proposed in the above paragraph.
