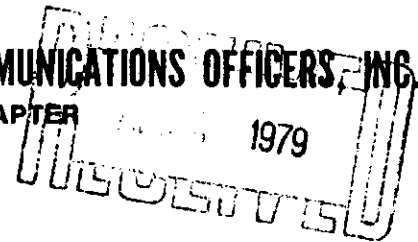

- f) He served as Chairman of the Program Committee in 1969 when the National was held in Des Moines.

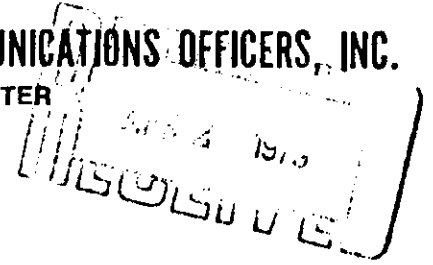
