RESOLUTION

"WHEREAS, there are now several national organizations of police officials in the United States, among which are the International Association of Chiefs of Police, the State Police Executives Association, the International Association for Identification, and the Associated Police Communication Officers, each of which has as its purpose the continued improvement of police science and administration and the promotion of police work as a profession, and

WHEREAS, these common objectives can be more effectively attained by keeping each organization informed of the activities of the other organizations and by joining together from time to time in cooperative undertakings of mutual advantage, now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Association subscribe to the principle of cooperation with other appropriate national police organizations for the purpose of improving the practice of police science and administration, and that the president and one member of this Association designated by him serve as its representatives for the purpose of developing with similar representatives of other police organizations various ways and means by which such cooperation may be brought about, any of which cooperative activities may be undertaken upon appropriate approval by this Association."
