

PRESIDENT BATTS:- Will you read the resolution Mr. Scroggin just presented to you, Mr. Kelly?

SECRETARY KELLY:- The resolution is as follows:-

RESOLUTION

"Whereas: The APCO realizes the necessity of strict adherence to the operating procedure promulgated by the Federal Communications Commission for the dispatch of inter-city messages, and,

Whereas: It is recognized that close cooperation between inter-zone and zone police stations is necessary in order to keep to a minimum the transmission of superfluous signals and incorrect procedure, including the incorrect use of the authorized procedure signals, and

Whereas: It is believed that the police departments generally will benefit by a self policing of their transmissions,

Now, therefore, be it resolved:

(1) That the operators of Inter-zone and zone police stations shall carefully observe the transmissions of their stations and record all cases of violations of the authorized rules and operating procedure and submit the same by mail in the form of a weekly discrepancy report to the stations causing the discrepancies.

(2) That a record of these discrepancy reports shall be maintained against each operator to the end that the entire operating personell of a particular station may be kept informed by a weekly report of the relative standing of the operators of his station from the standpoint of proficiency in transmission.

(3) That, in addition the name of the operator of each station who stands first on the list for his station, shall be published in the bulletin of the APCO, the name to be selected for this purpose to be that of the operator who has maintained the highest standing for his station for the three months period ending January 1st, April 1st, July 1st, and October 1st.

(4) That, for the purpose of uniformity all discrepancy reports shall be submitted in the following form:

1. Date
2. Time
3. Quotation of a sufficient part of the reception to insure identification of the material from the files of the transmitting station.
4. Underscore in the material quoted in (3) above each discrepancy which was observed in the transmission, thus:
