Am sending the APCO cuts to Bob, at his request, so he will have stationary printed, and forward it to you. Guess you had better send him a few bucks for stamps, too.

We're all set for experimental work, using a 6A6 - 803 - push-pull 860s combination which gives us 840 watts input on 2812 KC and feeding a half wave Hertz at the end, we get  $2\frac{1}{2}$  amps into the antenna. We're keying the oscillator and it follows a bug very nicely. We'll put up a 2036 antenna shortly, so we're waiting for Jett now and all we'll have to do will be to press the key. I understand I've been appointed "Technical Secretary" of the inter-city committee and that all six members (the "big six") to do experimental work will be on the inter-city committee.
